

## MANDATORY PROCESS TO APPLY FOR PERMISSION FOR ANY SAMPLING OF FOOD BEVERAGE OR CONSUMABLE AT NEW ENGLAND CANNABIS CONVENTION

If you plan to sample any food, beverage, or consumable, or even just to give out a non-cannabis-related food product such as candy, at NECANN Boston, you **must** follow these steps:

- 1. **BY MARCH 8, 2024:** Fill out the attached <u>Levy's Sampling Form</u> and send it along with a copy of the product manufacturer's <u>Certificate of Insurance</u> to Angelica Rodriguez, Catering Sales Manager, Levy Restaurants, angelica.rodriguez@levyrestaurants.com.
- 2. Next, fill out the <u>City of Boston Temporary Food Service Permit Application</u>. Send the application, along with <u>a copy of the Health Permit/License the manufacturer uses to produce the product</u> to Carolyn Weston, Show Director, carolyn@necann.com by February 24, 2024. DO NOT SEND ANY PAPERWORK TO THE CITY OF BOSTON DIRECTLY! NECANN SHOW MGMT MUST SUBMIT ALL APPLICATIONS!
- 3. As soon as the Temporary Food Service Permit Application is approved, you will receive instructions and a link from the City of Boston via an email on how to pay the appropriate Temp Food Permitting & Administrative Fee. Permit fee is based on the number of days you plan to sample. First day is \$30. Then it's \$5 for every additional day, so for a two-day show, fee will be \$35. Administrative fee is \$100. You will need your permit application number to make this payment.
- 4. Once your Temporary Food Service Permit is obtained, you must <u>send a copy of the permit</u> to Angelica Roderiguez, Catering Sales Manager, Levy Restaurants, angelica.rodriguez@levyrestaurants.com in order to be able to sample at NECANN. (Permit must be on file with Levy Restaurants.)
