

### Can I buy tickets at the venue?

YES, CASH ONLY, \$25 ticket good for both days. Box office opens at 9:30am both days.

### Where is the best place to park?

The Champlain Valley Expo has lots of surface parking surrounding the venue.

### Do I need a medical marijuana card to attend? NO.

Are pets allowed? NO. Only registered service animals are allowed.

Is there an age requirement? YES. 21+ unless accompanied by parent/guardian.

Do I have to buy a ticket for my child? NO. Children under 18 accompanied by a parent do not need a ticket.

Is my ticket transferable? YES, to edit the name on your ticket, email kris@necann.com.

### What is the refund policy? All tickets are non-refundable.

### Can I bring a bag/backpack? YES.

Champlain Valley Expo security reserves the right to search all bags/backpacks and may refuse any bag to be allowed in. NECANN will store rejected bags at the registration desk. 




