AIRPORTS: The Atlantic City International Airport

Located a short 12 miles (approx. 18 min) outside of Atlantic City, the Atlantic City International Airport is a convenient option.

Serviced by Spirit Airlines, the airport offers service to/from Atlantic City as follows:

- *Starting April 11, 2022, customers can book service to/from ACY (www.aa.com)*
- *The service began on June 3, 2022*
- *Service is offered three times daily. Beginning July 5th, 2024, the luxury motorcoach service will increase to six daily roundtrips*
- *Customers begin their trip at their local airport (ACY) and check-in with American to check bags and clear security. (TSA NOW approved the security clearance; July 2023)*
- *They would then board a Landline vehicle to arrive in PHL.*
- *Once at PHL, they'll deboard airside, enter the terminal and proceed directly to their connecting flight.*
- *When they return home, guests will board a Landline vehicle in PHL and arrive at their local airport (ACY). Checked bags will seamlessly be transferred.*

TRAIN:

- The Septa High Speed Rail Line train (www.septa.org) runs from the Philadelphia International Airport to 30th Street Station. **The estimated fare is \$6.00.**
- The *Atlantic City Train Station* is conveniently located adjacent to the Atlantic City Convention Center. The Train Station is serviced by New Jersey Transit.
- New Jersey Transit (www.njtransit.com) provides service from 30th Street Station in Philadelphia. Trains run on the hour.
 - *Estimated cost from Philadelphia to Atlantic City is \$10.75 per person (prices subject to change).*
- Philadelphia 30th Street Station is serviced by AMTRAK (www.amtrak.com) AMTRAK provides service from all major East Coast destinations including New York, Boston and Washington, DC to the 30th Street Station.
